Welcome to Estonia! We are proud to host the 12th AGG World Championships in Tartu, the second largest city of Estonia. Tartu, with its population of 100 000 and lying 185 km south of Tallinn, is also the centre of Southern Estonia. The first written records of Tartu date from 1030.



Tartu is a vibrant student and university town. University of Tartu was founded in 1632 by Swedish king Gustavus II Adolphus. Its main building is one of the most outstanding examples of classical architecture in Estonia, which has stood at the centre of Tartu nearly 200 years.
