- You must provide local transportation for the expert(s) (between airport and hotel, and hotel and training centre).
- Since this is a single country camp, you can decide as you wish about the accommodation of your coaches.
- We may decide to invite one or two countries that are not yet part of the Age Group Programme or to which we cannot safely send our experts to attend with an observer coach. We will inform you if any such country wishes to attend. Moreover, you may also include other nearby countries. There is no fee and no citizenship requirement for age group camps.
- This is intended to be a practical in-gym camp but there will be some theory and/or PowerPoint sessions. We will need a projector and screen in the gymnasium.
- The gymnasium should be equipped with Parkour coaching and AGP testing needs such as benches, staffs, tape measure as indicated in the Age Group Programme Manual. Please note the AGP manuals for all disciplines are available in three languages for open access on the FIG website.
- The proposed daily schedule (09:00-12:00; 14:00-17:00) will be sent soon and can be modified to meet your internal needs but please plan for two three-hour sessions daily and inform the FIG Office of your preferences.
- Please send the list of your participating coaches on the attached form no later than October 4th, 2025.
